

Office Safety Precautions in Effect During the Pandemic

Our office is taking the following precautions to protect our patients and help slow the spread of the coronavirus.

- Clients are screened at the onset of each appointment with a brief, verbal questionnaire regarding current risk factors or symptoms associated with COVID-19.
- Office seating in the waiting room allows for safe distancing of six or more feet.
- Clients and staff will wear masks in session unless determined to impact a medical or mental health condition or the medically necessary treatment thereof.
- Clients and staff will maintain safe distancing.
- Restroom soap dispensers are maintained, and everyone is encouraged to wash their hands.
- Hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol is available in the office, the waiting room, at the reception counter, and throughout the building via sanitation stations.
- In-person appointments are scheduled at specific intervals to minimize the number of people in the waiting room.
- We ask all patients to wait in their cars or outside until no earlier than 5 minutes before their appointment times.
- Pens, toys, and other areas that are commonly touched inside of the office are thoroughly sanitized after each session.
- Physical contact is not permitted.
- Tissues and trash bins are easily accessed. Trash is disposed of on a daily basis.
- Common areas, including other areas throughout the building, are thoroughly disinfected by Pacific Continental Realty (PCR) at least two times per day.
